- The applicant **MUST** be a member of a Delta County ASTRA club.
- Scholarship applicants will be informed by April 30th on the status of your request. If selected, you are asked to attend one of the Club's meetings, after being awarded the scholarship, to introduce yourself to the Club, detail your proposed studies and accept your scholarship.
- Proof of enrollment must be submitted to Altrusa before the scholarship funds are issued. The funds will be sent directly to the student.
